

# Comit. International du Vaurien

## Rule of Cups

### 1. General

This rule organizes the cups, given under the responsibility of the Comité International du Vaurien (CIV).

### 2. Listing of Cups

The cups after rule 1 are listed as follows:

- a) - CUP CIV
- b) - Cup Mieke Pannevis
- c) - Europa-Cup
- d) - Masters Cup.

### 3. Awarding system

#### a) CUP CIV

The Nations Cup will be given after the final result of the World Championship. Only National Vaurien Class Associations (NVCA) with a minimum of two boats, sailing on the World Championship, can take part in this competition. Exceptions on question of a NVCA need the agreement of CIV. The Nations Cup will be given to that nation, which placed their last team in front of all other last teams in the final result of the World Championship.

#### b) Cup Mieke Pannevis

The Cup Mieke Pannevis will be given to that lady (may be helmsman may be crew), which is on the best place in the final result of the World Championship.

#### c) Europa Cup

The Europa-Cup will be given to that team, which is the winner of the competition "Europa-Cup". This competition has own rules.

#### d) Masters Cup

### 4. Prize giving

#### a) CUP CIV

The Nations Cup will be given on the World Championship for one year as a challenge.

#### b) Cup Mieke Pannevis

The Cup Mieke Pannevis will be given on the World Championship for one year as a challenge.

#### c) Europa Cup

The Europa-Cup will be given on the World Championship for one year as a challenge. It consist of two prizes.

### 5. Responsibility

CIV (secretary) is responsible for recording the names and addresses of the winners from all prizes under rule 1.

CIV is responsible for informing the organizing club of a World Championship about this rule.

The winners NVCA is responsible for supplying the prizes on begin of World Championship to the organizing club.
